



## LUNCH AND BREAKFAST INFORMATION

Welcome back to school. Breakfast and lunch prices will remain the same as last year for students with a slight increase for adult meals. Lunches are \$2.05 and breakfasts are \$1.40. Milk purchased with a home lunch will be \$0.35 even if you qualify for free or reduced lunch. Please keep track of your account and keep a positive balance. Reduced price lunches cost \$0.40 and breakfasts are \$0.30. Please fill out an application for free/reduced lunches to qualify for these benefits. Applications must be filled out yearly. Your student will carry the same status as last year until October 6<sup>th</sup> when all students without an approved application for this year will revert to full price status.

### Free and Reduced Lunch Applications

Our school receives extra funding, if we qualify, based on the number of our students who are eligible for free/reduced lunch benefits. Please fill out an application if you believe you may qualify.

Applications for free and reduced lunch can be processed in one day's time when they are filled out online. You can go to [www.ccsdut.org](http://www.ccsdut.org), click the departments tab and then choose child nutrition program.

We no longer have paper applications available but can help you apply at the school if you need a computer or internet access. If you have a foster child, you will need to fill out an application for them to qualify for free lunch. Just check foster child and you do not need to add your income information. All school-aged children in income eligible households can receive school meal benefits regardless of the immigration status of household members and information provided by the household will not be used for immigration-related purposes. No information regarding free and reduced lunch status will be available to anyone besides the lunch secretary and the parent who applies. Parents who are not listed on the application will have no access to this information.
