Student Safety Tips:

To help support our efforts to keep students safe, here are a few reminders about our drop-off/pick-up protocols.

- Pull all the way forward to improve access for all vehicles.
- Students should enter on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- North Circle Pickup:
 - o Approach from the north.
 - Exit with a left turn, heading back to the north.
- South Circle Pickup:
 - o Approach from the south.
 - Exit with a right turn, heading back to the south.
- Parents are expected to remain in their vehicles during drop-off and pickup. However, if assistance with car seats is required, please pull to the end of the pickup area to avoid disrupting the traffic flow

To help strengthen safety efforts, dropoff/pickup car traffic across the student crosswalk is strongly discouraged.

Dear Nibley Elementary Community,

This month we will hold another Fire/ Evacuation drill on March 21st at 2:00 p.m. This is the drill that we practice most often due to state law. This school year we have a Fire/Evacuation drill scheduled five times. Our Evacuation standard response protocols (SRPs) are followed to help us evacuate in a safe and thorough manner. (This SRP document is attached for your information.) Once we are outside, teachers and staff verify that everyone in their class is safe and wait for a radio roll call for status. When all has been reported as safely evacuated, we return to our learning locations. This entire procedure usually takes less than 10 minutes.

We continue to use our DIRs software app to help staff members better communicate during an event. We also use the loud fire alarm that lets everyone, including dispatch, know that the fire alarm has gone off. In addition to those alerts, we continue to use our own PA system to help staff know if this is a legitimate drill or emergency. Each classroom of students is equipped with supplies in a rolling bucket, for an actual emergency. A monthly drill or alert helps us stay ready in case we have a real emergency.
