Health Care Plan interventions should be followed for students with asthma. If a student's symptoms do not improve with the use of an inhaler, or if multiple symptoms are noted, the student should be sent home.

INDIVIDUALS MUST BE SYMPTOM AND FEVER FREE (WITHOUT THE AID OF MEDICATION) FOR 24 HOURS BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL. IF STUDENT IS FOUND TO HAVE A POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19 FOLLOW THE STATE COVID-19 SCHOOL MANUAL FOR INSTRUCTIONS.

Complete all steps and check boxes when done

- THE STUDENT'S MASK SHOULD BE REMOVED IF THEY ARE HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME BREATHING, ARE NAUSEATED OR VOMITING, ETC.**
- Have the student wash their hands thoroughly for 20 seconds.
- Take student's temperature.
- Use the symptom checklist to document the student's fever and other signs and symptoms. Student's with any symptoms on the checklist are to be moved to the isolation room.
- Call the parents and request that they immediately come pick up their student who is unwell.
- If parents are unavailable, contact parent emergency contacts to come pick up the unwell student.
- Used gloves and masks should be discarded appropriately.
- Perform thorough hand hygiene.
- Document all information for students who become ill, including student's signs and symptoms, interventions, thermometer results, and disposition of the student after the visit is completed.
- All sick and/or quarantine rooms disinfected when the student goes home.
