

Green Canyon School Community Council
Minutes September 14, 2020
Held in the GC Lecture Hall at 7:00 a.m.

1. In attendance: Dave Swenson (admin), Randy Bennion (admin), Shane Jones (admin), Cheryl Benson (parent), Steve Bunnell (parent), Diana Calderwood (parent), Shelly Halling (parent), Anita Oldham (parent), Rhonda Wright (parent), Alexis Bird (faculty), Max Jones (counselor), Christy Carroll (faculty), and Terri Rhodes (school board rep)
2. Steve B. called the meeting to order at 7:10 a.m.
3. The council has the correct number of parents to faculty ration, so there is no need to bring new members onto the council this year.
4. Steve B. called for nominations for new officers for the 2020-2021 school year.
 - a. Shelly H. nominated Rhonda W. as chair. Christi C. seconded. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
 - b. Rhonda W. nominated Diana C. as vice-chair. Christi C. seconded. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
 - c. Christi C. nominated Shelly H. as secretary. Cheryl B. seconded. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
5. Steve B. turned the meeting over to Rhonda W.

7. SCC training in October. Date to be determined. Probably conducted via Zoom. Terri R. reported that the school district will decide if the training will be held virtually. Terri asked if we prefer a virtual or in-person meeting. The consensus was either format is fine.
8. Dave S. reported that the students are doing a good job wearing masks and following social distancing rules. Anita O. asked if there is reported cases of COVID-19 at Green Canyon. Randy B. reported that there are 11 cases in the district and 2 positive cases at GC. Rhonda W. asked what the protocol is for exposure. Randy B. said COVID-19 exposure is defined as contact, with or without a mask, for longer than 15 minutes within 6 feet of an individual who tests positive. Diana C. asked what the benchmark is for classes or the school to go online. Randy B. explained that 3+ positive cases in a classroom will cause a class to go online for 14 days, and 15 simultaneous active cases in the school with cause the school to go online.
9. Dave S. explained that the administration is discussing various options for returning to school in the event the school needs to go online for 14 days.
10. Dave S. is using the money earmarked for the Solution Tree Conference to provide training for teachers to strengthen their online teaching skills. The conversation then transitioned into a discussion about the Trustland Plan. Dave S. will create an addendum to the Trustland Plan, and the SCC will vote on it in October.
