SCHOOL SAFETY: Randy followed up on the discussion from February. Civilian Response to Active Shooter Event (CRASE) training is a 4-hours training that is and will continue to be implemented at GC. The training is extended to faculty, staff, and other personnel. Custodians are the next group to be trained. The 2-hour Stop the Bleed training will take place in August. The off-site evacuation location is in the RSL building. Students follow the same procedure as a fire-drill, which requires students to report to their third- hour teacher upon gathering in the RSL building. Randy B. is working with the district on a parent/student reunification plan. Cheryl B. asked if the video the SCC watched in February will be shown to the students. Randy B. said the video is not scheduled to be viewed by the student body, but Randy B. will consider doing that. LeeAnn P. recommended sharing the link to the video on the school website. Randy B. will send the link to Shelly H. to include in the SCC minutes, and he will put the link on the school website.
