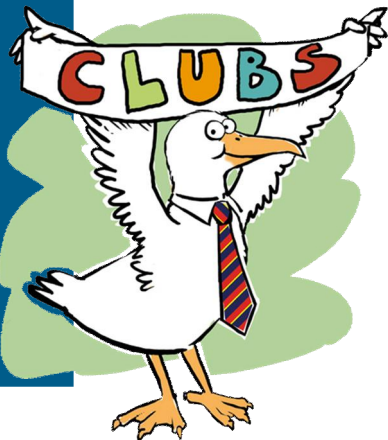
REACH Program

The Liberty Card Fundraiser will begin on Thursday the 10th of September. Watch for more information coming home with your student.

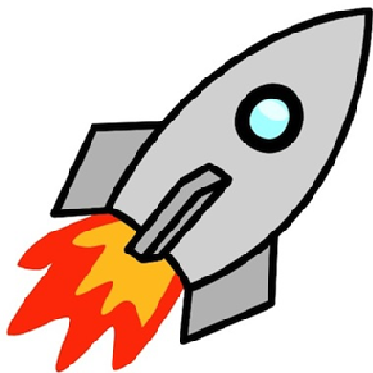
