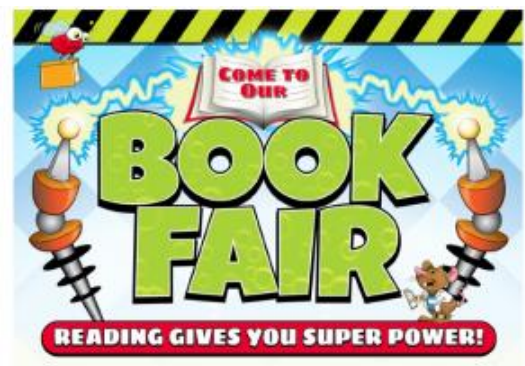

The media center will be having a Book Fair the week of February 16-19. Come check it out!

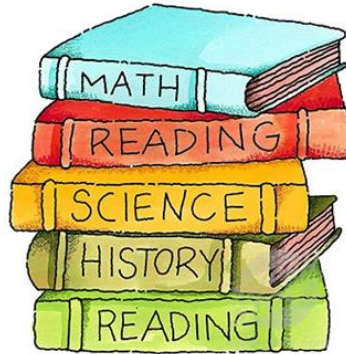


MISSION: ~~POSSIBLE!~~ No Missing Assignments
