“Counselor's Corner”

My name is Holly Stuart, and I am the school counselor at Greenville. I grew up in Star Valley, Wyoming, and am still a farm girl at heart! USU is where I decided to get my education, so I moved to Logan. My husband and I live in North Logan. We have two daughters and two special granddaughters. I love nature, working in my yard, being with my family, and working with children.

At USU I received my Bachelor's degree in both Elementary and Secondary Education. I have taught at the elementary level for 21 years in the Cache School District. Recently, I went back and received my Master's degree in School Counseling, and here I am now!

My role, as a school counselor, is as follows:

1. Each month I will be in your child's classroom teaching guidance curriculum lessons. Lesson topics may comprise friendship, conflict resolution, peer pressure, bullying, etc.
2. I will also work with individual students as needed. This may include coping skills, anxiety, problem solving, social skills, family support, etc.

3. As the year progresses, I will be working with small groups on leadership, being a team player, ownership, etc.

You will be contacted, and a consent form sent home, before any individual or small group counseling begins. These services are available to all students. Please know that if your child comes to see me, it is NOT because they are in trouble. When we meet, I am their advocate. As a school counselor, I am another adult in the school providing tools to help them succeed.

My schedule is Greenville on Monday, Wednesday, and alternating Fridays, depending on the need. The other days, I am counseling at River Heights Elementary. Feel free to contact me anytime.
