
PICK UP & DROP OFF SAFETY

Thank you for being safety minded first, and for helping us to ensure that all students are safe at Heritage Elementary.

The safest place for student drop-off and pick-up is at the curb and sidewalk of the front circle drive.

Students should NOT cross 3200 S unless using a crosswalk. There should be no drop-off or pick-up of students behind the school at the dead end on 3020 South or in the roundabout near the portable classrooms.

It is unsafe for students to exit or enter a vehicle before it has pulled up safely alongside the curb and sidewalk of the circle drive.



The school parking lots are reserved for parents who need to park their vehicle and can escort their children safely across the parking lot and crosswalks to the school building and back. Please use only marked parking spot so as not to block others.

Please DO NOT leave your car parked or standing in the front circle.

If you are not exiting the car with your children, you are required to use the circle drive for curbside drop-off and pick-up.
