Heritage Science Fair Information and Tips:

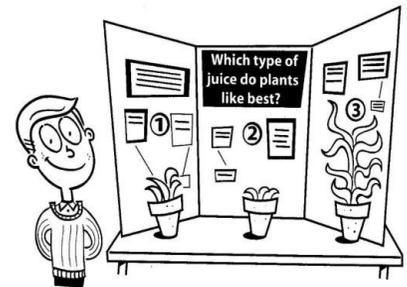
How does a doorbell work? Why do plants grow up and not down?
