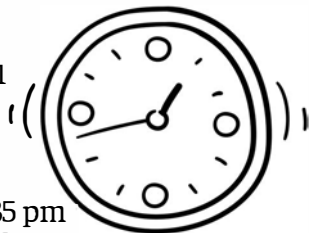

Any amount of reading qualifies for a prize.

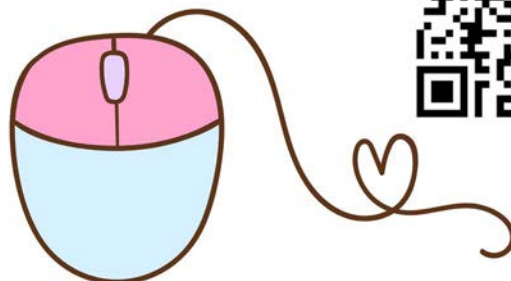

Get ready for an amazing evening of discovery and learning!

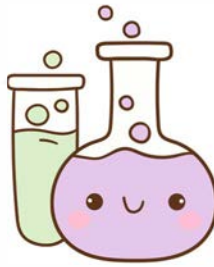
Our school's S.T.E.A.M. Night will take place on Wednesday, January 30th, from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM.

Students and families will have the opportunity to explore fascinating hands-on activities that bring science, technology, engineering, art, and math to life in fun and interactive ways.

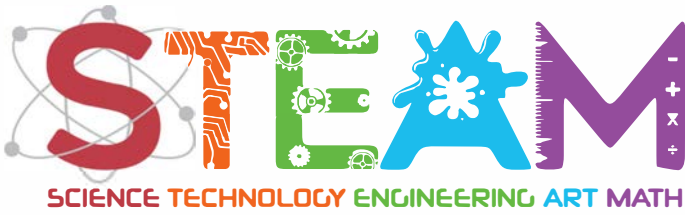

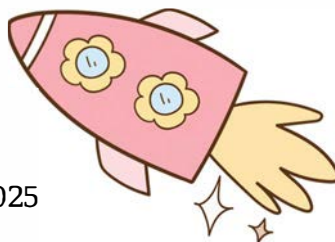

Speaking of being prepared, we'd like to remind families about P.E. footwear. On your child's designated P.E. day, please ensure they wear or bring tennis shoes.

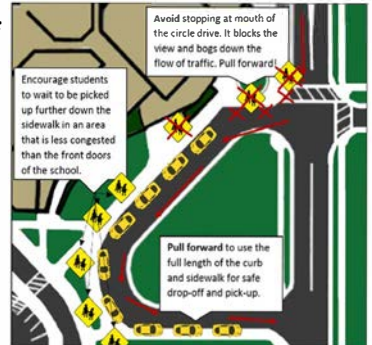
Proper footwear is important for safety and participation in physical education activities. A little preparation goes a long way in keeping our students comfortable, safe, and ready to learn!



SAFETY FIRST AT HERITAGE

We appreciate your partnership in keeping our students safe during arrival and dismissal times. To ensure everyone's safety, please follow these important guidelines:

- The safest place to drop off and pick up students is along the curb and sidewalk of the front circle drive.
- Never drop off or pick up students behind the school on 3020 South or in the roundabout near the portable classrooms.



- Students should exit the passenger side door.
- Cross 3200 South only at designated crosswalks.

For parents who need to park and escort children:

- Use the school parking lots and park only in marked parking spots.
- Ensure you safely walk children across parking lots and crosswalks.
- Do not leave your vehicle parked or standing in the front circle.
- If you are not exiting the car, please use the curbside drop-off and pick-up lane.
