Playground	Play fairly. Take turns. Listen to adults. Use kind and respectful words. Include others in your play. Use your own class equipment.	Bring in all playground equipment. Keep shoes on feet. Put on a coat when it is cold before you go out. After you eat lunch, use the restroom before you go outside.		Play gently. Stay within the playground boundaries. Stay away from the white fence. Use the playground equipment appropriately: Go down the slides, go south to north on the bars. Playground equipment is not for playing chase or dodge ball. Kick balls on the grass not the blacktop. Ropes are for jumping only. What's on the ground should stay on the ground — including snow. Do not push others off the snow hills. No sliding on the ice. Stay out of puddles.
